

ORDINANCE NO. 2

AN ORDINANCE LIMITING AND REGULATING
THE USE OF MUNICIPAL WATER AND ESTABLISHING
PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF

In order to preserve the water pressure levels of the municipal water supply in the Town of Frankford as well as to assure an adequate supply of water for all citizens of the Town, the Town Council has enacted the following Ordinance regarding the use of municipal water being supplied by the Town of Frankford to its citizens, viz:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Frankford:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for any customer, person, corporation, partnership, association or other legal or commercial entity to use municipal water supplied by the Town of Frankford for purposes of watering, irrigating or filling residential or commercial lawns, gardens, farmlands, swimming pools or any real estate except during the hours of 7:00 P.M. until 10:00 P.M. of each day.

Section 2: It shall be unlawful for any customer, person, corporation, partnership, association or other legal or commercial entity, directly or indirectly, to knowingly allow, conduct or participate in the resale or the withdrawal, tapping or other removal, consumption, transportation, distribution or depletion of the supply of municipal water for any use other than that of servicing the normal residential and commercial uses and consumption thereof as a direct consumer within the boundaries of the Town of Frankford without the express written permission of the Town Council of the Town of Frankford.

Section 3: Any customer, person, corporation, partnership, association or other legal or commercial entity and the agents, servants, or employees thereof or any other person who commits, takes part, or assists in any violation of this present Ordinance, upon conviction thereof, shall be guilty of violating the law of this State and shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$100 for each incident and the cost of prosecution. Each day any violation of any provision of this Ordinance occurs or continues to exist shall constitute a separate violation and shall be subject to a separate fine as above provided and cost of prosecution.
