

ORDINANCE NO. 8

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE STREET NUMBERING
OF PROPERTIES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS
OF THE TOWN OF FRANKFORD AND PROVIDING
PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

WHEREAS, it is deemed desirable and in the best interest of the property owners and residents of The Town of Frankford that all properties within The Town of Frankford be numbered thence reducing confusion when calls for assistance from police, ambulance or fire protection agencies are necessary.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of The Town of Frankford, in Council met, in the manner following, to wit:

Section 1. The owner of every property, immediately after having the number or letter of the property duly assigned by the Town, shall procure and place such number or letter of not less than three (3) inches in height and shall place such number or letter in a conspicuous place near the main entrance of the property in order that such number or letter shall be visible from the street on which the property fronts or faces. Roman Numerals and Script not acceptable.

Section 2. The Town Clerk shall keep a chart showing the proper street number or street letter of every lot within the Town.

Section 3. In case of a number or a letter being allotted to a vacant lot, the procuring and posting of a number or letter shall be optional with the owner until an improvement is placed upon the property.

Section 4. If the owner or occupant of any building shall not place the proper number or letter upon the property after the number or letter has been assigned, the Town Clerk shall post or cause to be posted such number or letter and shall charge the cost thereof to the owner or occupant of the property. No certificate of occupancy shall be issued by the Town Clerk on any building constructed subsequent to the adoption of the Ordinance until such number or letter required by this Ordinance has been placed upon the property.


Section 5. In addition to any other remedy available to the Town pursuant to the provision of this Ordinance, any person, firm or corporation, who fails or refuses to place the number or letter on the property within ninety (90) days after a number or letter has been assigned to said property, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof by a court of competent jurisdiction shall be fined not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) and shall pay the cost of prosecution.

Section 6. For the purpose of the Ordinance, each day that a violation continues after the expiration of the ninety (90) day period following the date that a number or letter is assigned to the property, shall be deemed to be a separate offense.
