

ORDINANCE NO. 1

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING
MODE OF ENACTMENT OF FUTURE ORDINANCES

In order that the minimum procedural requirements may be established respecting future Ordinances to be enacted by the Town Council of the Town of Frankford,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Frankford:

Section 1: Every proposed ordinance shall be introduced in writing and in the form required for final adoption. No ordinance, except those relating to the budget or appropriation of funds, shall contain more than one subject, together with provisions for the violation thereof, which shall be clearly expressed in its title. The enacting clause shall be "Be it Ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Frankford." Any ordinance which repeals or amends an existing ordinance shall set out in full that part of the ordinance, sections or subsections to be repealed or amended, and shall indicate the matter to be omitted by enclosing it in brackets and shall indicate new matter by underscoring or by italics.

An ordinance may be introduced by any member at any regular or special meeting of the Town Council. Upon introduction of any ordinance, the Secretary of the Town shall distribute a copy to each elected official of the Town Council; shall preserve a reasonable number of copies in the Town Office; shall enroll the said Ordinance in the Minutes of the Council; and upon enactment thereof shall keep at least one copy of the same in a book to be provided for that purpose for ready examination and reference in the Town Office; and shall cause a copy of the same, if enacted, to be published at least once in a newspaper having a general circulation in the Town of Frankford.

Section 2. Except as otherwise provided in the Ordinance itself, every adopted ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its receiving a favorable vote from a majority of the members of the Town Council at any regular or special meeting thereof.

ORDINANCE NO 1A

ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION ONE OF ORDINANCE NO. 1, AMENDING TO PROVIDE PUBLICATION OF ORDINANCES BY TITLE ONLY.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Frankford has determined that the necessity of publishing ordinances in their entirety is too cumbersome and expensive; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Frankford has determined that the basic purpose of publication is to notify the citizens of the Town of actions taken by Town Council; and


WHEREAS, the Town Council believes that publishing the title of ordinances serves the purpose and provides notice to the citizens of actions taken by the Town Council.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Frankford in council met:


Ordinance No. 1, Section One, is hereby amended by adding to the last clause thereof to read as follows:

"... and shall cause a copy of the same, if enacted, to be published by title only at least once in a newspaper having a general circulation in the Town of Frankford.
