WHEREAS, the Town of Frankford supports the goals of the Federal Fair Housing Law,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Frankford heartily encourages all parties involved in the renting, selling or financing of housing in the Town of Frankford to ensure that no person shall, on the grounds of race, color, national origin, religion, creed, sex, marital status, familial status, age, sexual orientation or disability be discriminated against or denied a fair and equal opportunity to housing.

AND BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED, that the Town of Frankford take meaningful actions that, taken together, address significant disparities in housing needs and in access to opportunity, replacing segregated living patterns with truly integrated and balanced living patterns, transforming racially or ethnically concentrated areas of poverty into areas of opportunity, and fostering and maintaining compliance with civil rights and fair housing laws.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town of Frankford, when acting as administrator of a Community Block Grant, is hereby authorized to take such actions as deemed necessary to affirmatively further fair housing in connection with the said Community Development Block Grant.
